

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIDEAU LAKES

BY-LAW 2002-26

BEING a By-Law to designate a reduced load period for municipal highways, necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Corporation of the Township of Rideau Lakes.


WHEREAS Subsection 7 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O.1990 c. H8) provides that:


The Municipal Corporation or other authority, having jurisdiction over a highway, may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies. 1981, c.48,s. 10, part.

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Township of Rideau lakes and therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rideau Lakes enacts as follows:


1. The provisions of Subsection 7 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act apply to all Township roads within the Township boundaries during the period from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, inclusive in each and every year.
2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.


