To prevent garbage disasters by woodland critters, keep your garbage bags and cans inside until the morning of your collection day. Garbage cans with secure lids will also help to ward off dogs, birds and other critters. If your bags are ripped apart at curbside, it is your responsibility to clean up the mess. Tip: covering bags with a tarp or old blanket keeps the birds away.

When disposing of decaying material such as food scraps (especially fish scraps) during hot weather, freeze them before placing at curbside. Do not stock pile your garbage, as bags will not be picked up if worms are present.
