

## **2017 EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Lower Beverley Lake Park, Delta, Ontario**

#### **Competition 2017-01: Security Attendant**

**1 position with 35 hours/week effective May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

Under the direction of the Maintenance / Security Supervisor, the attendant will be responsible for ensuring that all park rules, regulations and policies are being adhered to during the overnight hours within the park. The attendant will also be responsible for processing reservations during the evening shift.

Preference will be given to those candidates who are currently enrolled in a related program at College or University and are returning to school in the fall.

#### **Competition 2017-02: Housekeeping Attendant**

**1 position with 30 hours/week effective April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

Under the direction of the Canteen / Housekeeping Supervisor, the attendant will assist in the general cleaning of 11 cottages and the washroom / shower facilities within the park.

Days and hours of work will vary and will include weekends and holidays.

#### **Competition 2017-03: Canteen Sales Attendant**

**1 Position with 25 hours/week during July and August**

Under the direction of the Canteen / Housekeeping Supervisor, the attendant will be responsible for the preparation and serving of food and sundries at the Canteen while maintaining a clean and tidy workspace.

Days and hours of work will vary and will include weekends, holidays and evenings.

Preference will be given to those candidates who possess a Food Safety Training Certificate from the local Health Unit. Experience in cooking, preparing and serving of food would be an asset.

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Candidates for each position must possess a valid Class G drivers' license and a valid first aid / CPR certificate. Candidates must also have successfully completed WHMIS training and, prior to acceptance, are required to provide a criminal reference check report. A minimum of Grade 11 education or an equivalent in related practical and education experience is required. Candidates must be mature, responsible and able to work in both a team and individual environment.
