DELTA WATERFRONT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Delta Community Improvement Committee has selected the preferred option for design of the waterfront park and village core access point. The chosen design received the most votes at a public meeting on September 15 this year. The design includes:

- shoreline stabilization
- docks for motor boats, canoes and kayaks,
- accessible pathways through the park and down to the water,
- seating options at the waterside and throughout the park,
- an amphitheatre,
- new trees and plantings, and
- historic information signage.

Now that the design has been selected, the Committee is seeking grants to fund the project. The total anticipated cost is \$380,000, and the project can be done in stages as funding becomes available.
